Would you like bespoke support to build a clinical and academic mentorship team and

complete an application for a HEE/NIHR Clinical Lectureship or equivalent funding?

Birmingham Health Partners is delivering a new opportunity – Post-Doctoral Fellowship – to help you take the next step on your clinical academic career.

This 30-day programme, completed over nine months bridges the gap between doctoral level study and applying for a Clinical Lectureship, supporting progression along the HEE/NIHR pathway.

The programme will support you to:

- Complete outputs from your doctorate (if not yet completed) or ongoing publications
- Design a programme of research
- Build a post-doctoral clinical and academic mentorship team
- Complete an application for HEE/NIHR ICA Clinical Lectureship programme or equivalent

The programme also offers each Fellow up to £5000 to undertake further training, external visits

and for publication costs.

Fellows will have access to the University of Birmingham and University Hospitals Birmingham education facilities.

The programme is provided at no cost to Fellows and a single-payment grant will be paid to employers.
